Just an ordinary leg.

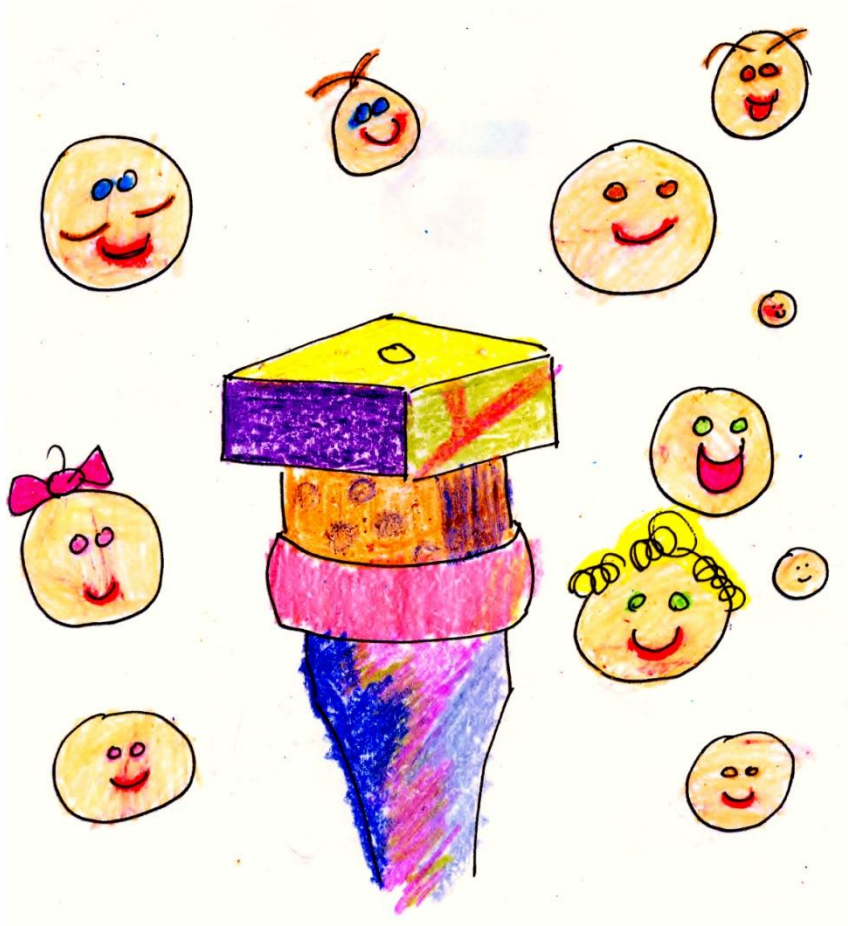
“An ordinary leg? Like one of a table or stool?

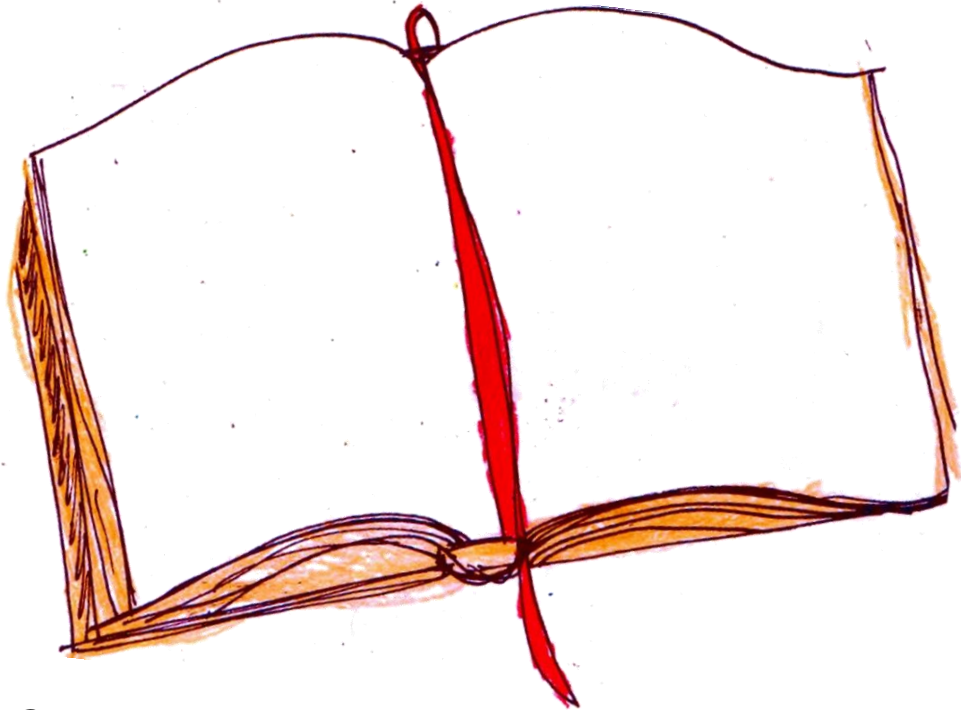
So Eleanor fled.

“My dear,” said a man. “Let us wipe your tears.

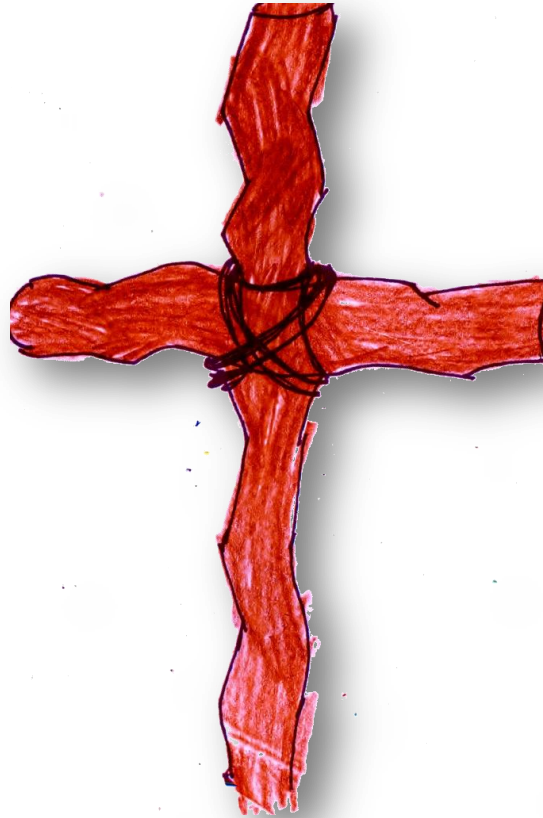
What seems to be your issue?”

He asked, giving her a tissue.

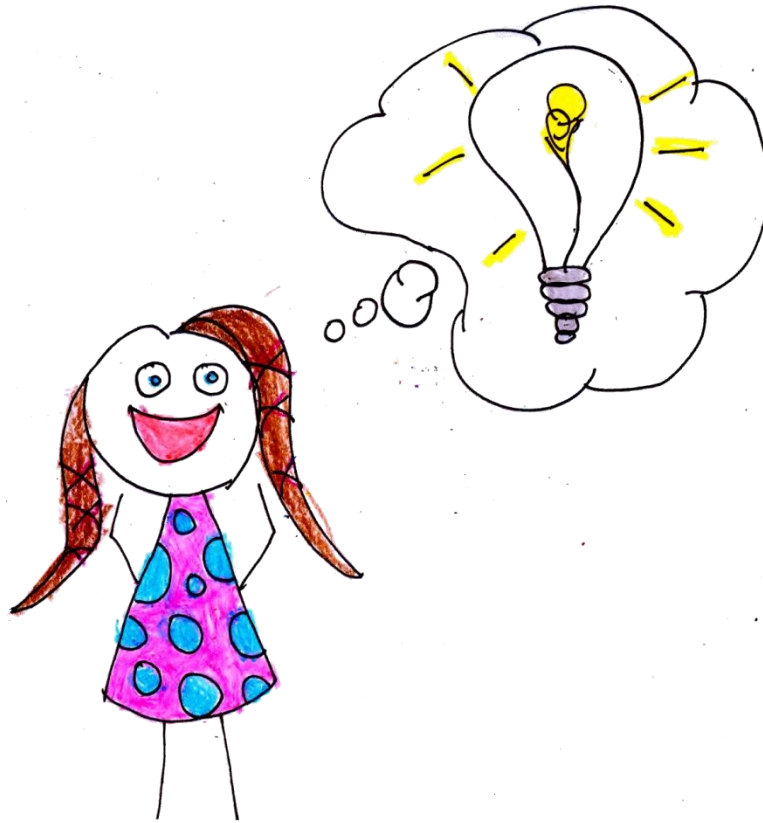


She told her story and then he told his.
